He opened up for Father Martin and Friends in November 1999 at the Delray Beach Tennis Center with his band and has performed his recovery show "A Musical Journey From Addiction to Recovery" at local AA and NA club houses. He has been featured on the television show "South Florida Presents" and has recently become one of the headliners at the annual "Recovery Fest" held in Boca Raton, Florida which had Eddie Money as last years headline act (2004). Matthew says, "When I got clean I didn't know what to do with my musical talents. I love music and am so thankful that God has given me this tremendous responsibility to carry His message of recovery in song." So listen to a few of the tracks and you will agree with many who have said that Matthew at times sounds like Lou Rawls, especially on his song "Baby Girl." "The greatest gift to me is when someone says that my music has touched their life; this is what I've been called to do."
